Northpark is home to 354 families with a housing mixture of public housing, tax credit, and fair market rate rentals. The USI Family Support team successfully

works with residents to create development plans that aim to ensure "All Families are Stable and Thriving". The team's success is contributed to the oversight of day-to-day service coordination, program design, and development and maintainance of a service consortium with the capacity to connect children and families to viable resources.

Propelling Educational Success:

USI's goal in the Northpark at Scott Carver community is to close educational gaps resulting from virtual learning and other systemic barriers to ensure all children have access to resources to address their academic needs. Currently, 80% (35 of 44) early learners age 0 to 4 are enrolled in early childhood education, with 73% screened for developmental delays; 30% of in school youth are connected to quality out of school programming.

Improving Health & Wellness:

USI's health and wellness goals aim to increase awareness and the importance of health-seeking behaviors among residents. Implementation of educational sessions and workshops will mitigate barriers to healthy lifestyles, enhance service linkages and coordination with healthcare insurers and providers, and create an environment that will help sustain healthy behaviors. Currently 78% of adults reported having insurance with access to a primary care physician; 97% of youth are insured and current with annual check-ups and immunizations.







Moving Families to Economic Self-Sufficiency:

USI partners with the local Women in Business, CareerSource, and other educational partners to mitigate barriers to employment. Currently 68% of adults age 18-64 are employed with an average household median income of \$29,623.

Engaging Families in Family Support:

For more than a decade, USI has implemented family supportive services for the Northpark at Scott Carver community, home to 354 families and more than 800 individuals. The Family Supportive Services team will continue working in collaboration with residents, community stakeholders and partners to ensure families are connected to comprehensive system of family support services. Additionally, the team will implement strategies that aim to mitigage barriers to healthy living, economic mobility, quality education and youth development programming.
