
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North Sarah

USI at North Sarah is leading the effort of connecting individuals to resources, partners, and opportunities in creating a pathway towards a STABLE and THRIVING life for all children and families in North Sarah .

The average household income is \$30,857



Propelling Educational Success:

USI works with local partners to increase children's participation in high-quality early learning programs and youth enrichment activities. Currently, there are 77% of scholars enrolled in positive out of school activities, 62% are enrolled in academic related support, and 39% in sports & recreation and youth leadership development.

88% of targeted residents have health insurance



Improving Health & Wellness:

USI assists residents in gaining health insurance and receiving consistent wellness or care appointments with their primary care provider for their families. Currently, 88% of targeted residents have health insurance and 94% have a primary care provider. 65% of families report they have a chronic health condition and 100% of the 65% are connected to an appropriate health care provider to manage their chronic condition.

77% of scholars are enrolled in positive out of school activities



Moving Families to Economic Self-Sufficiency:

USI is assisting all households with able-bodied working-aged (16+) youth and adults to grow economically through full time or part time employment, enrollment into a job train program, and/or empowerment of entrepreneurship within the community. Currently, 70% of families enrolled have wage income. The annual average earned income is \$30,857.

56 families are enrolled in Family Support



Family Support Services:

USI supports families through our Family Support Services, a version of case management that focuses on five key pillars to STABLE and THRIVING: economic mobility, education, health, housing, and policy and resident engagement. The Family Support Services are offered before, during, and after site redevelopment. North Sarah, a sustainability site, has (2) Family Support Specialists engaging in community outreach, supporting and building families. There are currently 195 participants (56) households that are actively engaged in services with USI.

USI Human Capital Communities

In order to create successful and thriving neighborhoods that include equitable pathways to social and economic mobility for families, USI plans and coordinates a thoughtful network of supports that operate concurrently with community revitalization efforts during the Planning, Redevelopment, and Sustainable life cycles of each community. To ensure the coordination of

these supports, USI provides a seamless family supportive services system to offer residents a single point of entry to a full continuum of resources, services, and programs. In support of Human Capital Communities, USI coordinates with property management staff for the delivery of on-site programs and services.
