Propelling Educational Success:

USI works with local partners to increase children's participation in high-quality early learning programs and youth enrichment activities. Currently, 168 or 69% of youth participate in out of school activities and 74 or 95% of youth have been screened for developmental delays.

Improving Health & Wellness:

USI assists residents in gaining health insurance and receiving consistet wellness or care appointments with their primary care provider for their families. Currently, 525 or 93% of assessed adults have health insurance.

Moving Families to Economic Self-Sufficiency:

USI is assisting all households with able-bodied workingaged (16+) youth and adults to grow economically through full time or part time employment, enrollment into a job train program, and/or empowerment of entrepreneurship within the community. Currently, the annual average earned income for families is \$33,036.







Family Support Services:

USI supports families through our Family Support Services, a version of case management that focuses on five key pillars to STABLE and THRIVING: economic mobility, education, health, housing, and policy and resident engagement. The Family Support Services are offered before, during, and after site redevelopment. There are currently 1150 individuals and 643 households that are actively engaged in intensive Family Support Services with USI.
